Cegep de Granby Haute-Yamaska patrons can connect to E.B. Online from the local computer network or from home with ID and password or [VPN authentication](#).

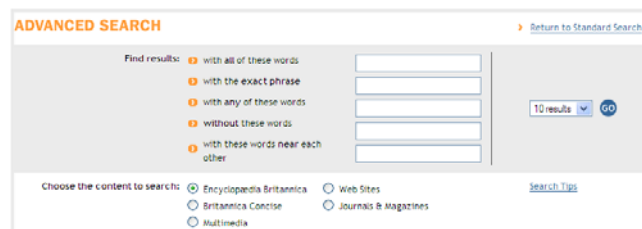
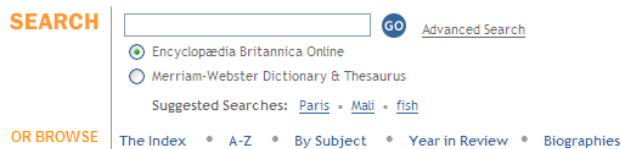
Step 1 : Go to Biblio-Web : www.cegepgranby.qc.ca/biblio

Step 2 : Click on the logo and Connect



From home, ask for an ID and a password ([Librarian](#) or English Teacher) or use our [VPN authentication access](#).

Step 3 : Select the Standard or the Advanced Search Mode
